Dear Parent/Guardian:

Happy Spring Everyone! Hopefully, we can finally enjoy some warmer days ahead!

2019-2020 Preshool Program:

The Plumsted Township School District will provide an Integrated Preschool Program that services children with special needs with typically developing children, together in one classroom. Each class will consist of three (3) and four (4) year old children selected from the New Egypt community through a lottery system, together with students from our pre-school disabled population.

The program will consist of half-day sessions. Hours of operation will be: **9:00 AM - 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM - 3:00 PM five (5) days per week. Applicants must be flexible regarding AM and PM placements.** In addition, we are offering a compliment program that will extend the child's day until 3:00 PM. This session will run from 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM and will have limited availability. The tuition rate for the half-day session is **\$308 per month** and the extended-day compliment program is **\$726 per month** for non-disabled students. Parents will be responsible for all transportation of the non-disabled preschool students.

Applications are available on the New Egypt Primary School website and will also be available in the main office of every school in the Plumsted Township School District. Applications must be submitted by mail to New Egypt Primary School at 131 Evergreen Road, Attention: Melinda Bowden, no later than April 17th.

Kindergarten registration packets are now available. Please visit our district website to download the packet. If you or anyone you know has a child that will turn 5 years old on or before October 1, 2019, please be sure to pick-up a packet. Dates for kindergarten readiness testing and orientation is included in the packet.

Spring Cleaning: In addition to your regular spring cleaning chores, consider adding something that will make your home a little safer for your kids;

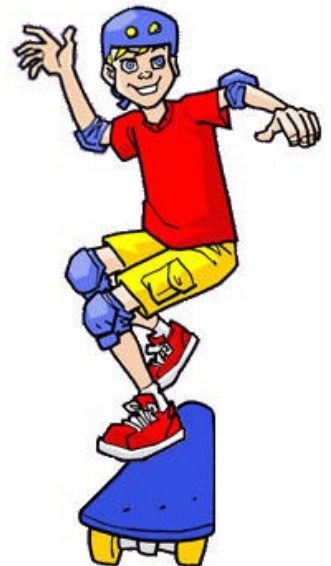
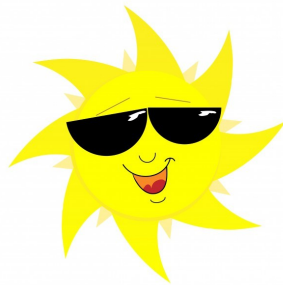

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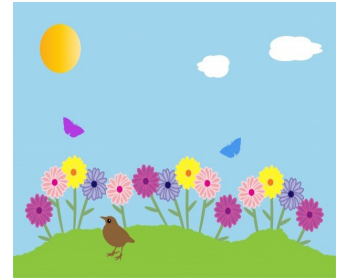
