Hello New Egypt Warriors and welcome to another season of Warrior Fall Athletics!

Fall sports and activities have begun and the boys and girls have been putting in a lot of practice time to get ready for their fall season. With the new regulations that are placed on outdoor venues, we had to make some adjustments to the protocols for game day.

Please review the following:

- All Pregame and Post game shaking of hand protocols are suspended.
- **FOOTBALL ONLY- Season Pass** tickets will be used for entry(Home games Only), no additional tickets will be available. Crowd will max out at 500. Tickets are meant for families of the participants as well as NEHS students only. 4 season passes will be distributed to football players, 3 season passes for families of cheer and band (Ticket Packets will be sent home). **NEHS Student Tickets will be distributed on Tuesday October 6th 2:30-3:30pm outside the Training room.**
  - Gates will not open for spectators until 6:30pm. Please adhere to social distancing while waiting inline to enter the stadium.
  - No Tailgating is allowed.
  - You must have a ticket prior to the game as there will be no tickets available at the stadium.
  - No one is permitted inside the building. Pre-game and half time will be conducted at a specified location in close proximity to the stadium. Stadium bathrooms will be available for use. Port-A-Johns for players only.
  - Snack Stands WILL NOT be open.
- **FIELD HOCKEY/SOCCER/TENNIS/CROSS COUNTRY-** Spectators will adhere to the 6 foot social distancing protocols.
- All spectators will be required to wear face coverings and socially distance as guided by NJ state laws. We ask that all protocols be followed.
- Failure to comply, will result in dismissal from the property and possible suspension or cancellation of the event.
- At the conclusion of the contest you are expected to clear the stadium and proceed directly to your vehicle or ride home.
