

Welcome to Warrior Camp!

We are excited that you have chosen The Wee Warrior/Warrior Day Camp/Warrior Adventure Camp to meet your child's summer needs. Camp Session

Camp begins with check-in at the New Egypt Middle School (115 Evergreen Road, New Egypt) main entrance at 9 AM each morning. Drop off parking is recommended in the front parking lot of the school. Camp ends each afternoon with check-out at 4 PM. Before camp is available starting at 7 AM and after care camp extends until 6 PM. Coupon books of 10 tickets can be purchase for \$40 and used for any combination of before and after care days. Refunds are not given on remaining coupons. Parents may also pay \$5 per day for each before and after care.

What to Bring

Please read carefully and make sure to have all of the following items daily. We appreciate your attention to this list.

- Small day bag/backpack (in which all the following items fit into)
- Refillable water bottle
- Lunch (disposable brown bag for those going on trips)
- Swimsuit/trunks (It is recommended to come to camp with bathing suit on under clothes).
- Towel
- Comfortable shoes to be worn – sneakers are recommended
- Flip flops or swim shoes are optional for water activity days
- Sunscreen (please arrive to camp with sunscreen on)
- Epipen, if medically necessary. A nurse is not available during camp and on trips.

Additional items for our Wee Warriors (preschoolers):

- Rest mat and any comfort items
- A plastic shoe box site tote with a full change of clothes and shoes. The tote may stay at the site for the duration of summer camp

Also, please note – wear clothing that can and will get dirty. Make sure to have campers name clearly written on ALL Personal items. This is important to make sure all of your items return home with you, plus keeps our valued attention with your camper and not on their gear. ***We are not responsible for lost, missing, or stolen items including any electronics brought from home.***

Breakfast, Lunch and Snacks

Campers may bring breakfast from home to enjoy at camp. Please make sure to bring all necessary items like utensils. Please pack a healthy nut-free lunch and snacks. We have campers that will be attending that have life threatening allergies to nut products. Please do not send any items that contain nuts, energy drinks or glass bottles to camp. In addition, snacks will be available at camp at no additional cost.

Swimming/Water Activities

We ask that campers come to camp with their bathing suit on underneath their clothes. This greatly maximizes our fun camp time together. We will change into dry clothes thereafter, so please make sure to have underwear and other necessary items to change into. If your child is not a strong swimmer or unable to swim, please make this known to us, if you have not already on the application. Your camper's safety is our utmost concern. Parents that do not wish to have their child participate on specific trips should notify the Camp Director.

Discipline

Warrior Day Camp is a school district sponsored camp. We expect campers to follow all school rules and to follow the established code of conduct expressed to campers by his/her counselor on opening day. Any camper behavior showing disrespect or disobedience to these guidelines will result in appropriate discipline. The counselor will be the first individual to deal with camper behavior problems. If a behavior continues negative behavior, the counselor will notify his/her head counselor for assistance. If negative behavior continues, the camp director will be notified and parents will receive the first phone call after the camp director speaks with the camper. The camp will contact you if your child is unwilling to change his/her behavior, shows a pattern of disobedience, exhibits violent, disruptive behavior or is assaulting (physically or verbally) other campers or staff. Campers who assault other campers will be dismissed from camp programs with no refund.

Payment/Cancellations/Refunds

We accept checks, money orders, cash and credit cards (with a 2.75% processing charge). **There are no refunds for missed/unused days.** Any questions, please see the Camp Director Mr. Valles.
